Job description: This position will perform the design, development, maintenance, and enhancement of computer applications with a focus on taking program or report specification documents and turning them into functioning program code or report output that accomplishes the objectives of those specifications. These services are critical for the CORIS P3 remediation and reporting activities (COMPAS and CADMUS applications) as well as the COMPAS version upgrade, with all development work scheduled to be completed by 02/22/10 (an update of timelines can be discussed directly with mgr if candidate is selected for interview).

This position also is performing the analysis and technical support functions for the COMPAS integration with CORIS

Finally, HR has requested enhancing employee wage tables to include W-14 associates, and this effort is due to be completed the end of February 2010.

Knowledge of the Systems Development Life Cycle and the principles and

techniques of analysis, requirements definition, designing, developing, and maintaining computer applications and reports.

Knowledge and skills in computer programming techniques and principles including, but not limited to, normalized database design, SQL/T-SQL, SSIS, SSRS, object-oriented programming, image creation/editing, XML/XHTML, CSS, Microsoft .NET framework (Active Server Pages), C#, JavaScript, and AJAX.; documentation skills; interpersonal skills and oral and written communications skills.

Some degree of hardware and telecommunications technologies is considered an asset.

Daily responsibilities to include:

- Test enhancement and development programs.
- Participate in structured code reviews / walkthroughs.
- Execute all required process steps.
- Utilize appropriate configuration management tools, design tools, debugging tools, and any other environment specific tools necessary to create, test, and implement an application or report.
- Follow quality standards.
- Communicate accurate and useful status updates.
- Ability to work in a team environment
- Complete assigned tasks.
- Strong communication skills; both written and spoken.
- Design applications to functional and technical programming standards.
- Work with BSAs to interpret user requirements into design specifications.
- Develop system specifications and interfaces.
- Determine time estimates and schedule for work.
- Moderate functional and process knowledge.
- Develop application designs in support of the systems specifications and interfaces, perhaps in conjunction with BSAs or application or technical architects.
- Execution of all responsibilities with little direct supervision of Team Lead.
- Determine time estimates and schedule for own work and resolve issues in a timely manner.
- Identify and track issues, risks and action items.

Plus the following:

- Plan all required process steps.

- Provide status of work to Team Lead.
- Anticipate, identify, track and resolve issues and risks affecting own work and work of the Application Team.
- Develop contingency plans as necessary.
- Detailed functional and process knowledge.
- Utilize deep modeling, design and coding skills.
- Provide expertise in one or more database environments.

DOC will perform the comprehensive criminal background check on site if selected however, please make sure your candidate is aware of this prior to submitting them.
